**Sub: Completion of 100 days – Problem regarding**

Madam,

Kindly note that in West Bengal, we have been focusing providing 100 days of employment to as much job seekers as possible. As of date, data in relation to the month of December'16 could be entered in the portal. Data in relation to the month of January'17 is still being uploaded. Unfortunately, till date, we could provide 100 days of employment to 50787 no. of households. However, if you look at the figure pertaining to between 81 to 99 days, right now we have a pull of 2.74 lakh of job seeker household. Now the specific problem faced in providing the same household till 100 days is complicating, arising certain checks in MIS system.

In specific cases, where muster rolls have been generated for 100 days of engagement, we do not have any scope of providing the required days of employment for the absent days in the generated muster rolls. This is all the most relevant to the muster rolls actually generated in later date than the date in which muster rolls were supposed to have been generated (1<sup>st</sup> day of work).

Technicalities have been discussed by our MIS team with NIC, Delhi. However, the issue is yet to have been resolved. You may kindly look into this so that we may provide 100 days of employment to the households which are closer to 100 days.
